1. The National Transport Corporation is inviting bids from interested parties for the sale of scrapped metals, aluminium & used bus batteries lying at its various Depots, in an **“as is where is”** condition, as more fully described at Annex 1.
2. Bidders should enclose with their bids, the duly signed Bid Securing Declaration Form at Annex 2. The price quoted in the local currency, shall be firm and all inclusive.
3. Interested parties may inspect the scrapped metals, aluminium & used bus batteries by calling the Senior Technical and Mechanical Officers at the National Transport Corporation on working days, between 10.00 hrs and 15.00 hrs. Parties will have to seek an appointment prior to the inspection, by calling the phone numbers given below:

4. The selected bidder(s) will have to remove the scrapped metal, aluminium & used batteries from the premises of the NTC, within ten (10) working days after being notified of the same in writing. Such removal will have to be effected on working days, between 8.00 hrs and 16.00 hrs. No removal of scrapped metals, aluminium & used batteries will be allowed during week-ends.
5. Bidders should be equipped with cranes or other lifting facilities for carting away of the items from the premises of the NTC. Possession of such facilities, or any acceptable alternative arrangement, should be clearly mentioned in the Bid Form.
6. Bidders will have to abide by the instructions and security arrangements in force at the NTC during the removal process.
7. The National Transport Corporation will not be responsible for any accident or damage to public or private property, once the scrapped metals, aluminium & used batteries have been removed from its premises.

8. Prior to the removal of the scrapped metals, aluminium & used batteries from the National Transport Corporation's depot, the selected bidder(s) shall be required to effect payment in advance and in toto for the lots allocated to him. Any variance in quantity will be adjusted to the quoted price and payment thereof should be effected to the NTC within 10 days from the date of notification.
  9. The quantity of the scrapped metals and Aluminium (Kgs/Ton) & used batteries (unit) for sale is approximate. The exact quantity will be determined as deferential at weigh bridge.
  10. Liquidated damages at the rate of Rs 500.00 per day for failure to remove the scrapped metals, aluminium & used batteries within the prescribed time, from the premises of the NTC will be applied and will have to be paid to the National Transport Corporation prior to the removal of the remaining items from the NTC's premises.

  12. The National Transport Corporation reserves the right to split the bid and does not bind itself to accept the highest or any bid, nor will it assign any reason for the rejection of a bid.
  13. **Bid Securing Declaration**
    - 13.1 The Bidder shall be aware of the content of the Bid Securing Declaration and shall subscribe to it by filling & signing it together with the Quotation Submission Sheet at Annex 2.
    - 13.2 If a Bid Securing Declaration is not respected, the bidder may be disqualified to be awarded a contract by the Public Body for a period of time as determined by the Procurement Policy Office.
  14. Offers in sealed envelopes marked "**RFS/NTC/26/08 – Sale of Scrapped Metals, Aluminium & Used bus batteries**", should be lodged in the **Tender Box A** situated on the 1<sup>st</sup> Floor (Photocopy Department), at the Head Office of the National Transport Corporation, Bonne Terre, Vacoas, not later than **Friday 08 May 2026 at 14.00 hours**.
  15. Bid opening will take place at the National Transport Corporation, Head Office, Bonne Terre, Vacoas on **Friday 08 May 2026 at 14.15 hrs**.
  16. Offers received after the specified time and date shall not be considered.
